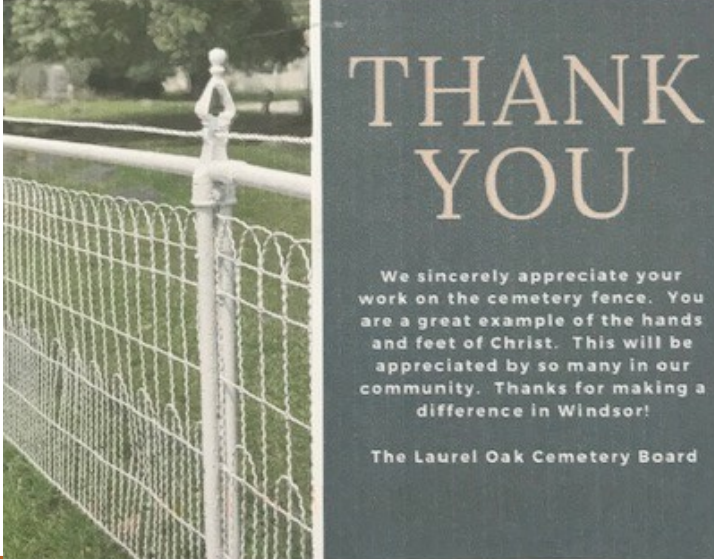

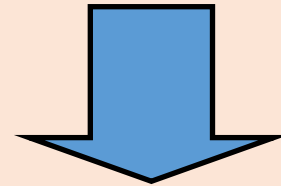
August is the month for school supplies. Don't forget, no liquid items such as glue. Bring your items to church and place them in the basket in the foyer.
