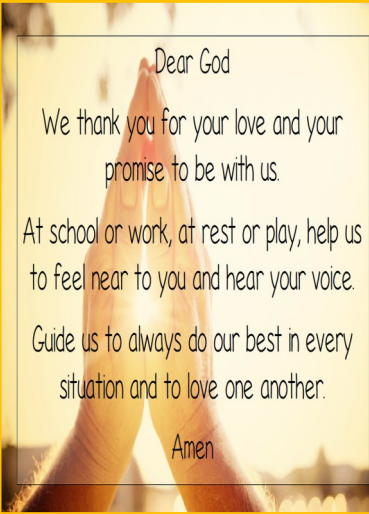
September Sermon Series:
